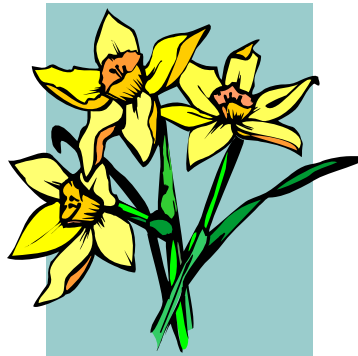
Happy Spring!
